Our Services include:

- **Acute Wound Management**
Surgical wounds, trauma wounds, burn care, acute wound infections
- **Chronic Wound Management**
Venous leg ulcers, arterial ulcers, diabetic ulcers
- **Pressure Ulcer Staging and Management**
Includes evaluation and ordering of pressure reducing/off-loading devices
- **Lower Extremity Edema/Lymphedema Management**
Includes compression wraps. (May be done in conjunction with Inland's Lymphedema Clinic).
- **Stoma Management**
Colostomy, Ileostomy and Urostomy



SPECIALIZED CARE

the most modern treatments, including VAC Therapy (negative pressure wound therapy), Electrical

Stimulation, MIST Ultrasound, Biosynthetic Grafts (Apligraf/Oasis Dermagraft), and Total Contact Cast.
